Event: Space Camp

Location: Bingemans Park

Date: May 13-15, 2016

Overall Risk Level 1, 2 or 3: Level 2

Right People, Place, Time, Equipment

- People: 21+ Cubs, 2 Beavers, 6 Scouters. Potentially a parent or two.
- Place: Bingemans Park. Scouter Andrew Bingeman has a family connection. Cubs & Scouters sleeping in yurts provided by Bingemans Park
- Time: 40 hours, 7pm Friday to 11am Sunday
- Equipment: all equipment supplied by 1st Elmira

Identified Risks and Countermeasures:

1. Injury

- a) First aid qualified leader with first aid kit
- b) 911 / EMS

2. Fatigue

- a) Ability to stop activity and rest
- b) Can call for parent pickup
- c) Food/water/shelter provided

3. Fear

- a) No youth are forced to participate
- b) Can call for parent pickup

4. Weather

- a) Outdoor location however severe weather not forecasted.
- b) All cubs have been advised to dress for the weather
- c) Shelter (yurts) provided

Location: Laser Quest Kitchener

Date: December 15, 2015

Overall Risk Level 1, 2 or 3: Level 2

Right People, Place, Time, Equipment

- People: Instructions on how to wear and operate equipment are given by staff
- Place: Indoor private business. Previous Cub outings have taken place here.
- Time: session runs for normal meeting duration
- Equipment: all equipment supplied by Laser Quest

Identified Risks and Countermeasures:

1. Injury
 - a) First aid qualified leader with first aid kit
 - b) d. 911 / EMS
2. Fatigue
 - a) space is available at Laser Quest to sit and relax if needed
 - b) Can call for parent pickup
 - c) Refreshments will be provided
3. Fear
 - a) No youth are forced to participate
4. Weather
 - a) Indoor location so if severe weather we will shelter in place
